I hope everyone is well as there is a lot of stuff we need to get to over the next several months.

So, another thing we need to get to this spring is to agree some ways to generate additional revenue. We've talked about this several times, and I got some good ideas at the meeting on January 8<sup>th</sup> but feel there's more things sitting out there we haven't considered.

I will probably get back to this at the second February meeting.

Over the last few years the club's membership has dropped from over 100 to about 80. We need to discuss how to reverse this trend.

A membership committee has been proposed.
