Draft Minutes of Board of Directors Meeting
(Subject to revision and adoption at July 28 Board meeting)

Board members present: Aaron Linn, Mike Broadhurst, Jim Bahringer , Art Chapman, John Nixon, Jim Beckman, Andy Zinn, Rocky Mullin and Greg Aitkens.

Other members present: Glen Baker, Teri Lord and Ryan Aikens.

Meeting called to order at 4:10pm by President Aaron Linn

Motion to approve the minutes of the July 2 Board of Directors meeting made by Mullin; seconded by Chapman; and approved unanimously. The approved minutes will serve as documentary evidence for approval of authorized signatures of Lions officers at local banks.

1. Decisions on Pinedorado Days

Motion to cancel 2020 Pinedorado Days event, including parade, made by Mullin; seconded by Beckman; approved unanimously.

Following discussion of an alternative event presented by Bahringer, the Board agreed to initiate planning for an event that would engage and support the community and maintain the presence of Cambria Lions and its sponsorship of a Labor Day celebration.

Motion to initiate planning for a drive-thru, complimentary meal event for the community on September 5, which may include use of the Lions' calliope, made by Broadhurst; seconded by Mullin; and approved unanimously.

Bahringer and Aitkens will lead planning for the event, and Board members should send ideas and comments to them prior to the July 28 Board meeting. At that meeting, Bahringer and Aitkens will present a complete plan for the event to the Board and attending Club members.

2. The Board discussed possibilities to increase Collaboration with and support of local schools. The discussion led to the fact that the Board has not approved a (Club) budget for the current fiscal year and that any discussion and action regarding support for students and schools should occur after the Club has an approved budget. The Budget Committee (currently Bahringer, Chapman, Brooks, Zinn, and Aitkens) will meet to develop a 2020-2021 budget for Board action.

3. Increasing and improving communication with Club members

The Board agreed that minutes of Board meetings should be sent to all Club members. The Board also discussed the possibility of holding a general membership meeting via Zoom; however, no decision was made for immediate action.

1. Holding Club meetings outdoors on Pinedorado grounds

The Board agreed to hold a general Club meeting on the Pinedorado grounds on July 28. The Board will meet at 4:00 p.m., and the general meeting will begin at 5:00 p.m. The Club will provide a light dinner and bar service. The food will be served (not buffet style).

Announcement will be sent to all members by July 22, and members must RSVP by July 25.

(Following the Board meeting, State mandates related to Covid19 reinstated the ban on indoor/outdoor gatherings, so the Club will not hold a general meeting on July 28.)

2. Financial Reports

An informal report (attached) was submitted by Brooks.

3. **Motion to adjourn at 4:56 made by Mullin; seconded by Chapman; and approved unanimously.**
